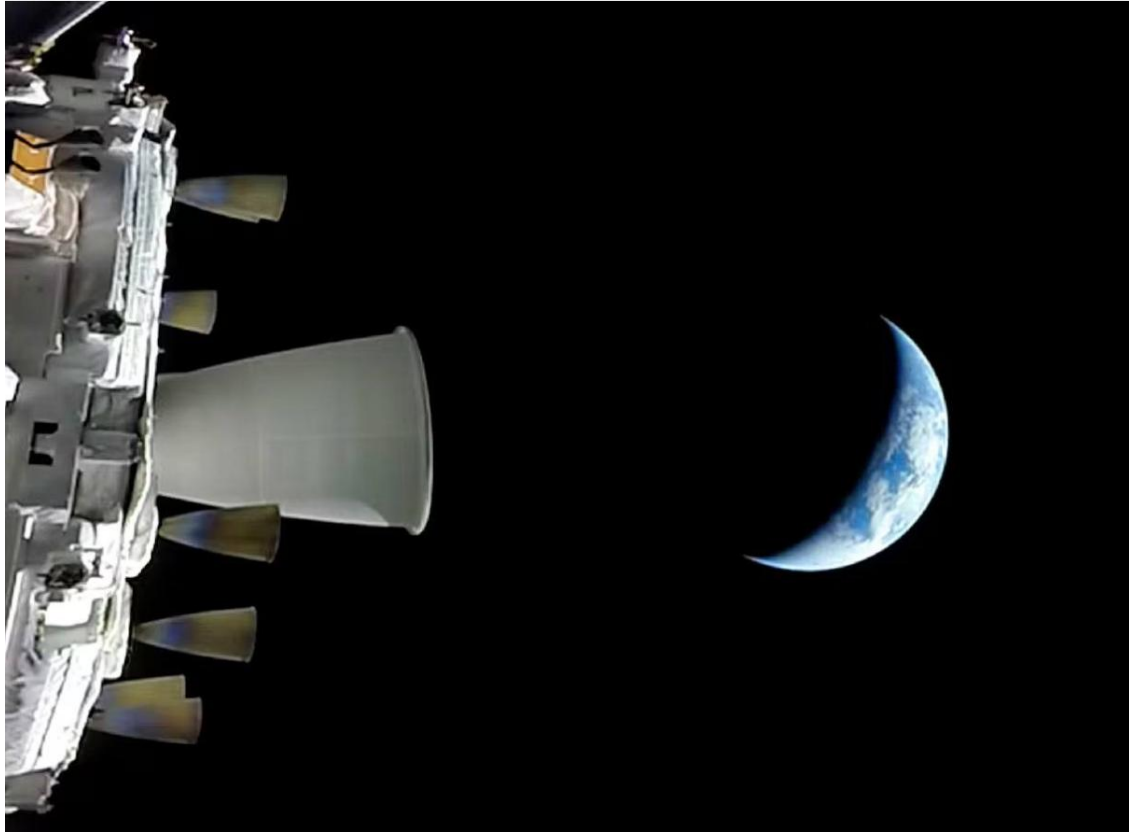

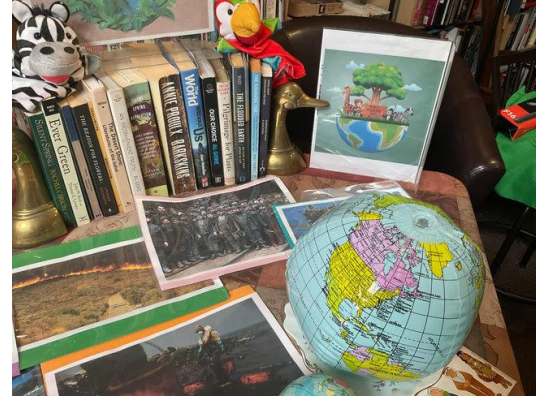

HARMFUL EFFECTS OF OIL, COAL, & GAS

1 OIL
The harmful effects of oil include environmental pollution from spills, habitat destruction, air and water contamination, contribution to climate change through carbon emissions, and geopolitical conflicts over resources.

2 COAL
The harmful effects of coal include air pollution with pollutants like sulfur dioxide and particulate matter, contribution to climate change due to high carbon emissions, destruction of landscapes through mining, health risks to miners, and water pollution from mining and waste disposal.

3 GAS
The harmful effects of gas include air pollution from combustion, greenhouse gas emissions leading to climate change, risks of explosions and accidents, and environmental damage from extraction methods like fracking.
